

Harold's Lake Dredging Project Kickoff

THURSDAY, DECEMBER 14 AT 2:00 PM AT THE WEIR (WEST SIDE OF HAROLD'S LAKE)

The Town of Belleair has hired Gator Dredging to complete the dredging project for Harold's Lake. Work will begin in early December and is expected to be completed in January of 2018.

How does dredging work?

Dredging is actually a simple process. A small barge will be placed in the lake and will remove silt from the bottom. This sediment will then be transported through a hose into a Gator Dredging truck (pictured). This truck sorts through the material and deposits the clean water back into the lake. This process continues until all excess sediment has been removed.

What can area residents expect?

This project will have a little-to-no impact and is minimally invasive. Residents may see the Gator Dredging truck parked in the area and the barge in the water; however, sound will be minimal and traffic will not be disrupted.
